All over Great Britain local governments are asking their residents to set up neighbourhood watch schemes although there are already over 4 million such schemes operating all over the country. This new interest in the idea came last week after the central government announced that crime rates had dropped by 39% over the last 10 years. It was also said that neighbourhood watch schemes had played an important part in this successful attempt to reduce crime.

Neighbourhood watch schemes have existed in the UK since 1982 but the idea came from the US where such a scheme was introduced in Chicago and proved very successful. The idea is rather simple and involves co-operation between local residents, the police, and some local organizations. While the main aim of this action is to reduce crime, especially burglary or vandalism, it also helps to look after those members of the local community who might need special care, such as old, sick or disabled people.

Neighbourhood watch schemes have come a long way since their beginnings when people thought of them as just a way for neighbours to poke their noses in other people's business. People no longer see them this way which means more and more local residents want to be actively involved in neighbourhood watch. The figures are clear – areas which already have neighbourhood watch schemes operating for some time were effective in reducing or preventing crime in 79% of cases in comparison to areas which do not have such schemes.

One of the local scheme officers told reporters: 'By working together neighbours can help reduce all sorts of crime. Anyone can become a member of a local neighbourhood watch scheme and play a part in its achievements.'
